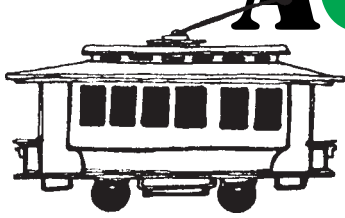

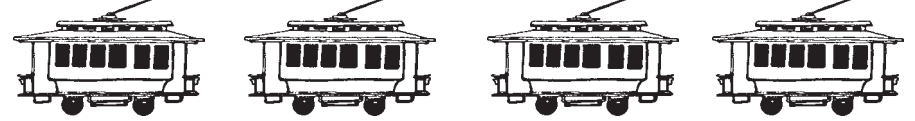

Port Authority Transit is in the middle of construction and repairs on the Mt. Washington Tunnel near South Hills Junction.

The first phase of the construction is blocking the inbound lane of the tunnel, forcing the morning trolleys up over the Warrington-Arlington hill. In a few weeks the outbound lane will be worked on and

the outbound trolleys will be coming through.

Whereas the trolleys have been able to use at least one lane, the bus traffic has been going through Allentown both outbound and inbound. Port Authority has posted some signs indicating that a number of buses will stop and take passengers to the junction.
